# Visa:

Travellers with citizenship from the following countries do NOT need a visa for entry:

- EU member states
- Switzerland
- Northern Macedonia
- Albania

all other citizens must apply for a visa. The application is uncomplicated. We will be happy to advise you on this.

#### **Entry requirements:**

Two doses (or one dose in the case of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine). At least 14 days have passed (28.02.22) since the date of the second vaccination at the date of arrival in Israel (but no more than 180 days (20.09.2021) at the date of departure from Israel).

### OR

Vaccinated with the booster dose and 14 days (28.02.22) or more have passed since the vaccination date on the day of arrival in Israel.

#### IF YOU HAVE RECOVERED

Recovered people can enter Israel, provided they carry a digital certificate of recovery that can be digitally verified by the Israeli Ministry of Health, based on a positive result in a PCR Test:

- Individuals who arrive in Israel 11 days (03.03.22) or more after their PCR Test (but no more than 190 days (10.09.2021) on the date of their departure from Israel)
- Individuals who, in addition to their recovery, have also been vaccinated with at least one dose of the WHO-approved vaccines.
